His word never returns void; His promises are for each and every one of us.

1 PETER 1:8-9

THOUGH YOU HAVE NOT SEEN HIM, YOU LOVE HIM. THOUGH YOU DO NOT NOW SEE HIM, YOU BELIEVE IN HIM AND REJOICE WITH JOY THAT IS INEXPRESSIBLE AND FILLED WITH GLORY, OBTAINING THE OUTCOME OF YOUR FAITH, THE SALVATION OF YOUR SOULS.

Walking in faith is loving Jesus, believing in Him, and rejoicing with an inexpressible joy! The more we know Him, the more we love Him. The more we love Him, the more we want to serve Him. Read through John 20:19-29 and take some time to meditate over the passage.

Have you ever found yourself wondering how you're going to make it through the tough seasons, or giving up when things seem impossible to overcome? Seasons of trial and tribulation are going to happen. However, when we place our hope, faith, and trust in Jesus, we can leave all those doubts behind! He is faithful; He is always with us and for us, faithful to complete the work He began.

Our faith and devotion are pleasing to God. When we surrender ourselves to Him, truly believing and fully trusting in Him, we return the love He so freely gives us. Just as Noah, Abraham, Isaac, and Joseph believed and trusted in God and His promises, we are called to do the same. He is faithful to keep His promises and reward His children.

JESUS SAID TO HER, "DID I NOT TELL YOU THAT IF YOU BELIEVED YOU WOULD SEE THE GLORY OF GOD?"

Read John 11: 1-44 for context. In this verse, Jesus is reminding Martha of His promises after she questions Him. It is easy to relate to Martha in this situation, because sometimes we can only see the obstacle that is right in front of us and forget that God has a purpose for each season we go through. When we walk in faith and obedience to what He commands of us, He reveals Himself, His plans, and His glory to us!

APPLICATIONS

What are some ways today's passage can be applied to your life?

PRAY

Write a prayer over today's passage.

JOHN 11: 25-26

JESUS SAID TO HER, "I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE. WHOEVER BELIEVES IN ME, THOUGH HE DIE, YET SHALL HE LIVE, AND EVERYONE WHO LIVES AND BELIEVES IN ME SHALL NEVER DIE. DO YOU BELIEVE THIS?"

Read John 11: 1-44 for context.

Jesus' resurrection of Lazarus is a literal representation of what salvation does for our souls. We can use this Bible story as a reminder of the salvation that God has freely given and promised His faithful followers! Jesus is the resurrection and the life, and when we believe that, though we may die in the flesh, our souls will be brought to new life!

JOHN 7:38

WHOEVER BELIEVES IN ME, AS SCRIPTURE HAS SAID, 'OUT OF HIS HEART WILL FLOW RIVERS OF LIVING WATER.'

Believing in God inwardly fills us with love and blessings that overflow to be poured out to others. As we walk with Him in faith, our hearts are changed, and out of the heart flows all of the thoughts, words, and choices of our life. From the heart flows the springs of life!

TUESDAY

FOR YOU KNOW THAT THE TESTING OF YOUR FAITH PRODUCES STEADFASTNESS. AND LET STEADFASTNESS HAVE ITS FULL EFFECT, THAT YOU MAY BE PERFECT AND COMPLETE, LACKING IN NOTHING.

Synonyms for “steadfastness” include faithfulness, loyalty, constancy, and closeness. So then, we could read James 1:3 as: the testing of your faith produces loyalty, constancy, closeness... FAITHFULNESS. Therefore, having our faith tested actually strengthens it! Through that strengthened faith we are made “perfect and complete, lacking nothing.”

PSALM 119:30

This verse is a great declaration to make to reenforce our faith! As we intentionally walk in faith with the Lord, and set our hearts on His word, we come more into alignment with what He calls us to, and this is pleasing to Him.

1 PETER 1:8-9

BY FAITH SARAH HERSELF RECEIVED POWER TO CONCEIVE, EVEN WHEN SHE WAS PAST THE AGE, SINCE SHE CONSIDERED HIM FAITHFUL WHO HAD PROMISED.

When God first told Abraham and Sarah that she would give birth to a son in her old age, she laughed, much like many of us probably would. But she did indeed give birth to Isaac (whose name means laughter) in God's promised time. As a result, her faith was strengthened.

Many of us can relate to Sarah. We have moments of doubt, during which God tests our faith to strengthen it. He always proves faithful, and we can keep Sarah in mind when we come into moments of doubt.

JAMES 2:17

SO ALSO FAITH BY ITSELF, IF IT DOES NOT HAVE WORKS, IS DEAD...

Have you ever heard the saying “you can’t talk the talk without walking the walk” or that “actions speak louder than words?” We can say we believe something all we want, but when our actions fail to support what we say, our words can fail us. While actions and good deeds alone cannot earn salvation, our faith is meant to be lived out in actions, that the world would see what it means to have Jesus as our Savior and Redeemer.

APPLICATIONS

Write a prayer over today’s passage.

MARK 10:52

**AND JESUS SAID TO HIM, "GO YOUR WAY; YOUR FAITH HAS MADE YOU WELL."
AND IMMEDIATELY HE RECOVERED HIS SIGHT AND FOLLOWED HIM ON THE WAY.**

This verse is a great example of believing that we receive what we ask of Him (Mark 11:23.) We can imagine that Bartimaeus probably expected Jesus to lay hands on him and speak a long, profound message (just like we would expect to happen,) but Jesus simply tells this blind beggar that his faith has healed him, and it's done. The Lord works in ways that we don't expect, yet we can count on the fact that He is working, regardless of the timing or the methods in which He does so.

TUESDAY

MATTHEW 21:21

AND JESUS ANSWERED THEM, "TRULY, I SAY TO YOU, IF YOU HAVE FAITH AND DO NOT DOUBT, YOU WILL NOT ONLY DO WHAT HAS BEEN DONE TO THE FIG TREE, BUT EVEN IF YOU SAY TO THIS MOUNTAIN, 'BE TAKEN UP AND THROWN INTO THE SEA,' IT WILL HAPPEN.

WEDNESDAY

MATTHEW 17:20

HE SAID TO THEM, "BECAUSE OF YOUR LITTLE FAITH. FOR TRULY, I SAY TO YOU, IF YOU HAVE FAITH LIKE A GRAIN OF MUSTARD SEED, YOU WILL SAY TO THIS MOUNTAIN, 'MOVE FROM HERE TO THERE,' AND IT WILL MOVE, AND NOTHING WILL BE IMPOSSIBLE FOR YOU."

THURSDAY

1 TIMOTHY 4:12

LET NO ONE DESPISE YOU FOR YOUR YOUTH, BUT SET THE BELIEVERS AN EXAMPLE IN SPEECH, IN CONDUCT, IN LOVE, IN FAITH, IN PURITY.

FRIDAY

HEBREWS 12:2

LOOKING TO JESUS, THE FOUNDER AND PERFECTOR OF OUR FAITH, WHO FOR THE JOY THAT WAS SET BEFORE HIM ENDURED THE CROSS, DESPISING THE SHAME, AND IS SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND OF THE THRONE OF GOD.

MARK 11:23

TRULY, I SAY TO YOU, WHOEVER SAYS TO THIS MOUNTAIN, 'BE TAKEN UP AND THROWN INTO THE SEA,' AND DOES NOT DOUBT IN HIS HEART, BUT BELIEVES THAT WHAT HE SAYS WILL COME TO PASS, IT WILL BE DONE FOR HIM.

How often are you really going to need to physically move a mountain? Probably never, but do you believe that He would make it happen if you needed it to? Often times we may come into seasons in which we face spiritual or emotional mountains, and it seems impossible to get to the other side. While there are things that we cannot do in our own power, He enables us to overcome any mountain that stands in our way.

MATTHEW 21:21

AND JESUS ANSWERED THEM, “TRULY, I SAY TO YOU, IF YOU HAVE FAITH AND DO NOT DOUBT, YOU WILL NOT ONLY DO WHAT HAS BEEN DONE TO THE FIG TREE, BUT EVEN IF YOU SAY TO THIS MOUNTAIN, BE TAKEN UP AND THROWN INTO THE SEA,’ IT WILL HAPPEN.

When you have faith, it WILL be done. When our faith in Him is strong, we will not fail. There is no limit to what God can do, and in Him, there is no limit to what we can do. God is limitless!

MATTHEW 17:20

HE SAID TO THEM, “BECAUSE OF YOUR LITTLE FAITH. FOR TRULY, I SAY TO YOU, IF YOU HAVE FAITH LIKE A GRAIN OF MUSTARD SEED, YOU WILL SAY TO THIS MOUNTAIN, ‘MOVE FROM HERE TO THERE,’ AND IT WILL MOVE, AND NOTHING WILL BE IMPOSSIBLE FOR YOU.”

In this passage, the disciples still have not come to fully understand the power of Jesus Christ, Son of God, who IS God. How often could we consider ourselves to be “of little faith?” We often fall into doubt when we face things that seem impossible, just as the disciples did because we can’t comprehend God’s full power either. There are things we cannot do without Him, but with Him we can do anything. It only takes faith the size of a mustard seed.

1 TIMOTHY 4:12

LET NO ONE DESPISE YOU FOR YOUR YOUTH, BUT SET THE BELIEVERS AN EXAMPLE IN SPEECH,
IN CONDUCT, IN LOVE, IN FAITH, IN PURITY.

Spiritual maturity is not dependent upon your age. You can be a faithful disciple at any age. We each are at a different place in our walk with Jesus, and we may be walking at a different pace. We have to cover ourselves in the full Armor of God to withstand the schemes of the devil and fight the good fight!
